Also known as “The Aquarium.” The oval-shaped reef is surrounded by a sandy bottom that slopes down to a depth of 12–20 meters. At Gota Abu Ramada, you can see everything the Red Sea has to offer in terms of schools of fish: schools of Red Sea gobies, bannerfish, and butterflyfish—and, unfortunately, schools of divers as well.
