Blue-spotted stingrays, nudibranchs, and wart snails are often found there. On the southeast side, gorgonian fans invite you to search for long-nosed wrasse, and at the northern corner of the reef, you should always take a look into the blue in search of hammerhead sharks or gray reef sharks.
